The UC-Mexico Initiative was mentioned in a front-page story of the LA Times this morning having to do with the deportation of families and the impact on their children, and particularly their education. This is related to the Students We Share work being led by the Initiative's Director of Education, Patricia Gandara.

Although not mentioned by name, the work of Dr. Gandara and others was also featured in a page 2 interview with Mexican Foreign Secretary Luis Videgaray, which ran in the LAT last Friday. In response to a question about integration of DACA returnees, Secretary Videgaray mentions a recent change to the general education law to provide immediate recognition of education certificates issued in the US. This came about as a result of legislative testimony provided by experts affiliated with Students We Share. Spearheading this effort was Senator Romero-Hicks, with whom President Napolitano met during her March trip to Mexico City.
